Sinclair Oil and Gas Company requests except ion to state wide rule # 303 and administrative approval to permit commingling of oil produced from the Drinkard Pool and the Paddock Pool on the Ollie Boyd lease in the NW/4, Section 23, T22S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The production from the Drinkard wells averages 5.7 BOPD, and 7.6 BOPD from the Paddock well. The gravity of each oil is 380 API, therefore, the commercial value of the commingled string remains the same.

Since the wells are marginal capacity, production will be allocated by periodic well tests as required by the Commission. Well tests are to be accomplished by shutting-in one well while testing another.

Attached is a schematic diagram of the commingling installation showing the leases and all of the producing wells thereon. If additional information is required, please advise.
