Reference is made to the telephone conversation of April 20, 1967, between Mr. Hastings of your office and Mr. Nutter of this office. Mr. Hastings pointed out that your recently completed Dodd "B" Well No. 18, located in Unit K of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, is within the horizontal limits of the Grayburg Jackson Pool, whereas all of the rest of the wells on this lease, being the north half of the section, are in the Square Lake Pool. Mr. Hastings further advised that Mr. R. L. Stamets of the Commission's Artesia office had been contacted regarding redelineation of the horizontal boundaries of these pools.

Pending such redelineation, Sunray DX Oil Company is hereby authorized to commingle Grayburg Jackson production from its Dodd "B" Well No. 18 with Square Lake production from the other wells on said lease.
