REQUEST FOR ADMENDMENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PC-332

Gentlemen:

Mobil Oil Corporation respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-332 dated October 2, 1967, and amended December 17, 1970, be further amended so as to permit the commingling of production from the subject well with the present commingled production.

Administrative Order PC-332 presently authorizes the commingling of production from Mobil's Bridges State Well #122, a Vacuum, Northwest Abo Pool single completion located in Unit I, Sec. 3, T17S, R34E, and Bridges State Well #123, a Vacuum, North Lower Wolfcamp Pool single completion, located in Unit O, Sec. 34, T16S, R37E. Both of these wells are marginal producers and production allocation is handled by quarterly well tests.

Well #166, located in Unit H, Sec. 10, T17S, R34E, has not yet been potentialed; however, we do not anticipate a top allowable well and would want to continue accounting for production from each well by tests conducted periodically as the Commission may prescribe. In the event Well #166 potentials at top allowable production from it would be metered.

Bridges State Tank Battery #122 into which Wells 122 and 123 currently produce is located in Unit I, Sec. 3, T17S, R34E, Lea County, New Mexico.

A request to extend the Vacuum, North Abo Pool to include the Vacuum, Northwest Abo Pool is now pending before the Commission. If this request is approved the problem of commingling production from more than two pools will be · eliminated.

The royalty ownership of all three wells is identical. Should additional information be required, please advise.





REQUEST FOR ADMENDMENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PC-332 TO INCLUDE THE COMMINGLING OF PRODUCTION FROM MOBIL OIL CORPORATION'S BRIDGES STATE LEASE WELL #166, VACUUM, NORTH ABO POOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Gentlemen:

Mobil Oil Corporation's Bridges State Well #166, located in Unit H, Sec. 10, T17S, R34E, Lea County, New Mexico, is presently being completed in the Vacuum, North Abo Pool. Upon completion of this well it is Mobil's desire to produce this well, on a commingled basis, into the Bridges State Tank Battery #122 located in Unit I, Sec. 3, T17S, R34E.

Order PC-332 presently authorizes the commingling of production into Tank Battery #122 from Bridges State Well #122, a Vacuum, Northwest Abo Pool single completion located in Unit I, Sec. 3, T17S, R34E, and Bridges State Well #123, $b - 157^{c-1}$ a Vacuum, North Lower Wolfcamp Pool single completion, located in Unit 0, $C \leq Sec.$ 34, T16S, R34E. Both of these wells are marginal producers and production allocation is handled by quarterly well tests.

While Well #166 has not yet been potentialed, a top allowable well is not expected. Therefore, the allocation of production would still be handled by well test. In the event Well #166 potentials at top allowable, production from it would be metered.

Mobil has requested the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to extend the Vacuum, North Abo Pool to include the Vacuum, Northwest Abo Pool. It is anticipated that this will be done at the September Nomenclature Hearing since .our request received favorable response and Mobil has not been asked by the Commission to present testimony at the afore said hearing supporting this pool extension.

State of New Mexico

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Since the royalty ownership is identical for all three wells and the future pool extension will eliminate a third pool, your approval of this application is respectfully requested.

A filing fee in the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00) is enclosed.
