O Gentlemen:

P Reference is made to your application dated April 26, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of undesignated Wolfcamp condensate production and undesignated Devonian oil production from your Southeast Lea Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit J of Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

Y We have now received the consent of the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico to the proposed commingling.

Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of it.
