Dear Sir:

Sun Oil Company hereby requests an exception to Commission Rule 303 and permission to commingle production from the Blinebry Oil Pool with production from the Drinkard Pool on the W. W. Weatherly Lease.

This lease is 100% Sun Oil Company interest with common royalty ownership and is located in Section 17, Township 21S, Range 37E, Lea County.

In Well No. 4-D the Drinkard Zone has been plugged off and the well recompleted in the Blinebry Oil Zone. We propose to commingle production from 4-D with that from Wells No. 2-J and 3-G which are producing from the Drinkard. All three wells are marginal.

Average daily production is as follows:

Well	#2							water -	W
Well	#3	2	bbls	oil	and	1	bbl	water	
Well	#4	14	bbls	oil	and	11	bbls	water	 EL

Gravity of the crude from the Drinkard is 35 API and sells for an average price of \$2.90 per bbl. Gravity of the crude from the Blinebry is 40 API and sells for an average price of \$3.00. Average price for the commingled crude is \$3.00 per bbl.


