AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-356

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 7, 1968, for an amendment to Administrative Order PC-356 which authorized the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard production on your W. W. Weatherly Lease in Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you wish to delete the Drinkard from this commingling installation and substitute Penrose-Skelly in lieu thereof. Further, that the Penrose-Skelly and Blinebry production is all of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-356 is hereby amended to authorize the commingling of Blinebry and Penrose-Skelly production on the subject lease, allocating production to each pool on the basis of periodic well tests, and provided that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
