Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated March 10, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of San Andres oil produced from your New Mexico "S" State Water Well No. 4 with Paddock production from your Paddock (San Angelo) Unit after separately metering the San Andres oil. It is our understanding that the San Andres production from the aforementioned Water Well No. 4 belongs to the unit.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counter on the meter.
