Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Lusk-Strawn and Lusk-Delaware production from your Plains Unit Federal Lease Wells Nos. 2, 3Y, 4Y, and 7, located in Sections 28, 21, and 33 of Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that one additional well, the No. 9, located in Unit F of Section 33 has been completed in the Delaware formation and that although a test separator is shown on the schematic diagram for the Strawn production, no test facilities will be installed for the Delaware production and that tests of said Delaware will be made by shutting in the remainder of the wells not being tested.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, Pan American Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said unit in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of the aforesaid commingling authority,
