Gentlemen:

Your letter of December 3, 1969, requests approval to commingle the liquids produced from the Mesaverde and Dakota formations from each of the following wells:

No. 1 Federal M, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 3, T. 27 N., R. 8 W., lease NM 05791  
No. 1 Federal R, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 15, T. 27 N., R. 8 W., lease SF 078476  
No. 1 Federal D, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 22, T. 27 N., R. 8 W., lease SF 078478  
No. 1 Federal I, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 15, T. 27 N., R. 8 W., lease SF 078476

You propose to utilize a common tank battery at each location and allocate liquid production back to the respective formation based on a well stream analysis. You also state that lease ownership is identical for each formation on all the leases affected.


