Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Gallup oil and Dakota condensate produced by your O. H. Randel Well No. 1 in Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each zone on the basis of periodic well tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, Clinton Oil Company is hereby authorized to commingle the aforesaid production in the above-described manner, provided that you shall allocate production on the basis of quarterly tests, and that you shall notify the Commission in the event that the Gallup zone becomes capable of top allowable production.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of the aforesaid commingling authority.
