Gentlemen:

Your letter of November 13, 1970 requests approval to commingle on the surface the liquid production from the Gallup and Dakota formations from dually completed well No. 1 Hillside, NW4SE4 sec. 9, T. 27 N., R. 11 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease Santa Fe 078872-A

As stated in your letter, the condensate from the Dakota formation has a gravity of  $59.7^{\circ}$  API with a value of \$3.05 per barrel. Oil from the Gallup formation has a gravity of  $44.4^{\circ}$ API with a value of \$3.05 per barrel. When combined the gravity will fall within the  $40-65^{\circ}$  pricegravity range with a value of \$3.05 per barrel.

Your plan for commingling liquid production on the surface is hereby approved provided that regular quarterly tests of production be made and commingled production allocated back to each zone based on this test.
