No loss by commingling production is anticipated. Without commingling long storage time between runs and greater surface area in extra storage vessels allows excessive evaporation. Selling the oil more rapidly will increase the volume and gravity of the crude, due to less evaporation of the "light ends".

Amerada Hess Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval to commingle production on the State D A lease and to allocate the Drinkard and Blinebry oil production on the basis of quarterly well tests.


