Gentlemen:

To eliminate the considerable expense of maintaining two tank batteries on the subject lease, we hereby request a surface commingling permit for the subject lease. We propose to commingle production (as per attached table) from the Shugart Yates/Seven Rivers Queen/Grayburg and Shugart Delaware Pools. The attached table shows the produced volumes and gravities from each pool.

Currently, both pool's production is being purchased by Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (Crude Oil Dept.) and is being transferred by Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Company's sour facilities lines. Attached is a letter from Chevron U.S.A. agreeing to purchase the commingled production. Also attached is a schematic of the commingled facility and a lease plat.

The commingling proposal is in the interest of conservation in that it prevents unnecessary waste and production expense.
