DESCRIPTION: S/2 SW/4, NE/4 SW/4, Section 15, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM



Production shall be allocated to each lease by well tests; (If this method or the subtraction method is to be authorized, all commingled production must be of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest, and overriding royalty interest.)

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: Production shall be stored in a common tank battery located in Unit J of said Section 16. This order supersedes Division Order No. PC-757.
