**Lease Name:** Rincon Unit Well No. 168E  
E/2, Section 36, Township 27 North, Range 7 West,  
Rio Arriba County.

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Basin-Dakota and South Blanco Tocito Gallup Oil Pool liquid hydrocarbon production in a common tank battery and to determine such production from each pool by an allocation factor. Such allocation factor shall be determined by initial production tests and by production tests conducted bi-annually thereafter.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
