Re: Application for Change in Unit
Well of Non-Standard Gas Prora-
tion Unit, Eumont Gas Pool.

Gentlemen:

Amerada Petroleum Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a change in unit well for the non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E/2 of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. That Amerada Petroleum Corporation is unit operator of a 320 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Pool consisting of the Amerada J.R. Phillips Lease which is the NE/4 of Section 1, the Amerada State "H" Lease which is the W/2 of the SE/4 of Section 1, and the Skelly State "D" Lease which is the E/2 of the SE/4 of Section 1, all in Township 20 South, Range 36 East. (See attached plat.)
2. That the non-standard gas proration unit was formed under NSP Order 230 dated February 8, 1956.
3. That the unit well is the Amerada J.R. Phillips No. 8 located 2088.5 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 36 East.
4. That because of mechanical difficulties in the Amerada J.R. Phillips No. 3 located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, Amerada wants to re-complete this well to a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool.
5. That the unit well for this 320 acre non-standard gas proration unit will be changed from the J.R. Phillips No. 8 to the J.R. Phillips No. 3, both in the same quarter-quarter section.

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6. That the J.R. Phillips No. 8 will be recompleated to an oil well in the Monument Pool.
7. That by copy of this application to change the unit well in this gas proration unit, all operators owning interests in the subject section and all operators owning interests 1500 feet from the unit are hereby notified by registered mail of this intent.

Therefore, Amerada Petroleum Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to make this change of unit wells as proposed in this application.
