Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eusant Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 21 South, Range 37 East  
NE/4 and W/2 NE/4 of Section 20

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your W. E. Lee Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line and in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 20, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPL, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eusant Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 12 of the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres after submission of proof of communitization to both the Santa Fe and Hobbs Offices of the Commission. X
