Continental Cil Jompany respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry gas pool of Order No. R-610 for the formation of a 120 acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the W/2 of SE/4 and the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, for its M. E. Vantz No. 4-A well located 660 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the east line of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Blinebry gas pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

- 1. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- 2. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental quarter section.
- 3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 2,640 feet.
- 5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5 (b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 4-A well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.


