Re: Application of TEXACO Inc. for Approval of an 80-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit; Tubb (Gas) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. hereby makes application for approval of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb (Gas) Pool comprising the N/2 of the NW/4 of Section 18, T-22-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following:

- 1. TEXACO Inc. is owner and operator of the C. H. Lockhart (NCT-1) Well No. 2 located in Unit "D", 660 feet from the north and west lines of Section 18, T-22-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat. This well has been a Blinebry (0il) producer since December 1, 1945, and is now being dually completed in the Tubb (Gas) Pool.
- 2. TEXACO Inc. is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the C. H. Lockhart (NCT-1) Lease, comprising 400 acres covering the N/2 of the NW/4 and the E/2 of Section 18, T-22-S, R-38-E with Well No. 2 located as stated above, and proposes that the N/2 of the NW/4 of Section 18 be established as an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order R-586, Tubb (Gas) Pool, with Well No. 2 as the unit well.
- 3. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit meets the requirements of Rule 5(d) of Order R-586, Tubb (Gas) Pool, as follows:
  - (a) The unit is comprised of contiguous quarterquarter sections.
  - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
  - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of Tubb gas.

- (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 2640 feet.
- (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the quarter section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of TEXACO Inc. to form the proposed nonstandard gas proration unit. (Addressee list on attached plat.)

Based upon the facts recited above, TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission approve administratively the non-standard gas proration unit described above.


