Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respect fully requests exception to Rule 5 (a) of Order R-1670 for approval of 240-acre non-standard Jalmat Gas Proration Unit, covering the NE/4 and N/2 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This non-standard unit is to be attributed to the Vinson-Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the north line and 330 feet from the east line of Section 12.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- √1) Gulf's Vinson-Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 2 is completed as a Jalmat gas well and is assigned a 160-acre non-standard unit covering the NE/4 of Section 12, by NSP-483, dated May 6, 1959.
- This well was originally drilled and completed as a dry hole on July 8, 1941. The well was re-entered on April 21, 1958 and was recompleted as a gas well on August 20, 1958. Gulf has previously been granted approval of an unorthodox well location by Administrative Order NSL-192, dated June 22, 1959.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lies wholly within a single Governmental section.
- (4) The entire non-standard gas proration unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Eumont Gas Pool.
- 5) The length or width does not exceed 5,280 feet.

All offset operators within 1,500 feet of the unit well have been furnished a copy of this application. Gulf owns all the leasehold interest in the section in which the non-standard unit is located.


