Re: Reinstatement of Administrative Order NSP-589 For Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, TEXACO Inc., Blinebry (Gas) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. hereby requests reinstatement of Administrative Order NSP-589, dated February 26, 1962, which was approval of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry (Gas) Pool consisting of the following acreage:

> Lea County, New Mexico Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM Section 29: S/2 SW/4

This order was issued when it appeared from tests that the gas-oil ratio of the Blinebry Oil Pool in the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-2) Well No. 5, had increased to 66,417 cubic feet per barrel which was in excess of the 32,000gas-oil ratic limit for the Blinebry Oil Pool. However, a multi-point back pressure test indicated a ratio of 28,434 cubic feet per barrel. As a result of the multi-point back pressure test and the request of TEXACO Inc., Administrative Order NSP-589 was cancelled by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission letter dated July 2, 1962.

The request for reinstatment of this order is based upon the following gas-oil ratic test data:

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By copy of this letter, all operators owning interest in the quarter section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators owning interest within 1500 feet of the unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of TEXACO Inc. to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. Offset operators notified are:

> Gulf Oil Corporation, P. O. Box 1938, Roswell, N. M. Pan American Petroleum Corp., P. O. Box 268, Lubbock, Texas Western Oil Fields, Inc., P. O. Box 1147, Hobbs, N. M.

Based upon the facts recited above, TEXACO Inc. respectfully request that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission reinstate Administrative Order NSP-589, thus approving the nonstandard gas proration unit described above which will be dedicated to TEXACO Inc.'s A. H. Blinebry (NCT-2) Well No. 5.

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
