
Re: Amended Application for Non-

On March 22, 1962, an application was made by Ralph Lowe for a 160-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit for his Sholes "B" 2 well located in the Jalmat Pool, 660 feet from the South and East lines of Section 25, Township 25S, Range 36E, Lea County, New Mexico.
