In accordance with Rule 4 of Order R-237³ (establishing temporary pool rules for the Lusk Morrow Field, made a permanent order in 1975) Petroleum Development Corporation hereby makes application for administrative approval of exception to Rule 2 which requires each proration unit to contain 640 acres.

Approval is requested for a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the west half of Section 10, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lusk Morrow Field, Lea County, New Mexico, for the recently-completed Sun-McKay Federal #1. Previous dedication of a 640-acre unit comprising all of Section 10, T19S, R32E, has been approved.

Approval is also requested for a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the east half of Section 10, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lusk Morrow Field, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed well for this unit, the Sun-McKay Federal #2, would be drilled at a location 1980' from North and East lines of Section 10.

Letters of request for a waiver of objection together with copies of this application have been sent to all offset operators by certified mail as indicated by the attached listing.

The following reasons are set forth for this request:

1. The entire 640-acre proration unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas from the Lusk Morrow Field, and can be efficiently and economically drained by the two aforesaid 320-acre non-standard gas proration units.
2. For the last several years, the 320-acre proration unit has been assigned to most Morrow gas wells and has been considered appropriate to economic and reservoir-drainage considerations.



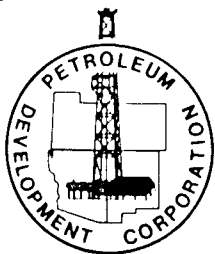
3. Recent drilling of second wells on 640-acre proration units in the Lusk Morrow Field have resulted in apparent economic producers. This, together with the lenticular nature of the Morrow sands, would seem to indicate that the smaller-size proration unit would not violate correlative rights of offset operators.
4. Approval of this application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the gas in the Lusk Morrow Field, will prevent the economic loss caused by lack of efficient drainage, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
