Reference is made to your application dated December 23, 1992 for a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Section 15: E/2

It is my understanding that the subject unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to the following two existing wells located on Conoco's State "D" Lease:

- Well No. 14 located at a standard gas well location 915 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit A) of said Section 15; and
- Well No. 17 located at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location (Division Administrative Order NSL-2282) 900 feet from the South line and 2150 feet from the East line (Unit O) of said Section 15.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a nonstandard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 5 of said pool rules based upon the unit size of 320 acres.
