Reference is made to your application of February 23, 1989, for a 226.61-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool:

RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM
Section 1: Lots 5, 6, 9, 10, and 11, the SW/4 NE/4, and the W/2 SE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your San Juan 31-6 Unit Well No. 201 to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 1490 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 1.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above non-standard gas proration unit is hereby approved.
