Reference is made to your application dated May 17, 1994 for a 200-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Section 29: N/2 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4, and N/2 SE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to the three existing wells on the Eumont Gas Com "2" Lease:

3	660' FSL & 1980' FWL	N	Non-Standard

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 and 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described non-standard gas spacing and proration unit and resulting unorthodox gas well locations are hereby approved. Also, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all wells in any proportion.

The current 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit comprising the N/2 S/2 of said Section 29, currently dedicated to both the Eumont Gas Com "2" Well Nos. 1 and 2, under authority of Division Administrative Order NSP-1688, dated April 4, 1994 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
