1 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, that same page, 2 Case 12,940, which is a matter that's being reopened 3 pursuant to Division Order R-11,856, Mr. Bruce and I were 4 recently involved in a case on those same pool rules. week Examiner Catanach issued an order in which he 5 addressed those pool rules and made them permanent, and the 6 7 order is styled R-11,856-A. So I think we can dismiss Case 12,940, because it 8 9 was dealt with in the order that was issued by Examiner Catanach. And I forget the case number, but the Order 10 Number was R-11,856-A, and it came out -- I think he signed 11 12 it last Friday. It was designated -- What happened, 13 MR. BRUCE: 14 Mr. Examiner, was that Mewbourne Oil Company applied to 15 reopen that case a few months ago, so it was styled 12,940 16 Reopened. And Ms. Davidson put the case back on the docket just because it was scheduled in her files to do so. 17 EXAMINER JONES: She put the original case back 18 19 on, or --20 Yeah, correct, so I think Mr. MR. It can always be 21 reopened again if there's some reason to. 22 EXAMINER JONES: Any other continuances and 23 dismissals?
