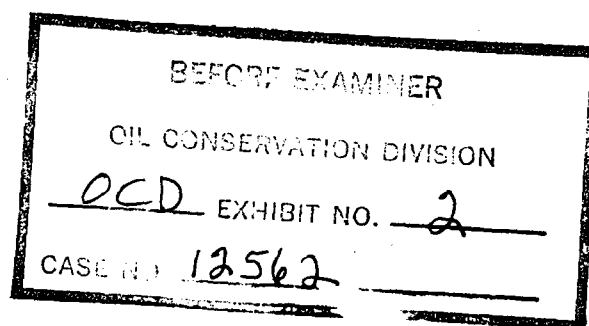
WHEREAS, The above principal has heretofore or may hereafter enter into oil and gas leases, or carbon dioxide (CO₂) gas leases, or

the drilling of wells to prospect for and produce oil or gas, or carbon dioxide (CO₂) gas or helium gas, or does own or may acquire, own or
operate such well, or such wells started by others on land embraced in said State oil and gas leases, or carbon dioxide (CO₂) gas leases, or
helium gas leases, and on land patented by the United States of America to private individuals, and on land otherwise owned by private
individuals, the identification and location of said well being expressly waived by both principal and surety hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, If the above bounden principal and surety or either of them or their successors or assigns, or any of them, shall
plug all of said wells when dry or when abandoned in accordance with the rules, regulations, and orders of the Oil Conservation Commission

1. On January 23, 1997, Debtors commenced these cases by filing voluntary Petitions for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
2. The employment of the firm of Lentz & Clark, P.A. as local counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors was approved effective February 14, 1997, pursuant to this Court's Order dated March 19, 1997.
3. On July 23, 1999, this Court entered an Agreed Order approving the First Interim Fee Application of Lentz & Clark, P.A., approving fees of \$35,711.00 and expenses of \$3,504.60 for total fees and expenses of \$39,215.60, which covered the period from February, 1997, through September 30, 1998. There is a balance due on the First Interim Fee Application of \$17,147.35.
4. On August 18, 1999, this Court entered the Order Confirming Amended Liquidating Plans of Reorganization For Petroleum Production Management, Inc. and Overland Resources Management, Inc.
5. This Final Fee Application covers the period of time from October 1, 1998, through August 20, 1999.
