## **IMMEDIATE ACTION REQUESTED**

Dear Ms. Wrotenbery;

On February 25th, OXY USA WTP, Limited Partnership, filed a motion seeking a stay of a drilling permit in the above referenced case pending the March 4th examiner hearing in the above-referenced case. Tom Brown Inc. responded to the Motion on February 26th. The reason for this request for stay is to prevent Tom Brown Inc. from commencing drilling of a well on the acreage that is the subject of the OXY pooling application and thereby maintain the status quo until the matter can be heard by a Division Examiner.

We have learned this afternoon that Tom Brown may commence drilling over the weekend. OXY requests an immediate hearing on this motion or, in the alternative, requests that the Division rule on this motion based on the written motion and response of the parties.
