WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 1:30 p.m.: 2 3 EXAMINER STOGNER: Call next case, Number 12,734, which is the Application of Richardson Operating Company to 4 establish a special "infill well" area within the Basin-5 Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as an exception from Rule 4 of the 6 7 special rules for this pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. 8 Call for appearances. MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom Kellahin of 9 the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin and Kellahin, appearing 10 11 on behalf of the Applicant. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe 12 13 on behalf of San Juan Coal Company. EXAMINER STOGNER: I understand we need to take 14 15 care of some procedural matters at this time? 16 MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, Mr. Examiner. Both the 17 Applicant and San Juan Coal Company have requested that you 18 set aside a specific day to hear this as a special hearing. 19 On behalf of Richardson Operating Company, we are 20 available the first Tuesday of the week ending the month of 21 October, which I think is the 27th. And in addition we 22 could -- the last Tuesday of October, I think, is what, the 27th? 23 24 EXAMINER STOGNER: Last Tuesday of October is the 25 30th.

MR. KELLAHIN: Thirtieth.

EXAMINER STOGNER: This is for October, right?

MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir. We're available, certainly, at your convenience anytime from now forward.

5 We would perhaps need a week for preparation.

In the meantime, Mr. Bruce and I have asked for a prehearing conference that would include you if you're the Examiner, and he and I to discuss potential issues with you at the hearing and decide on what issues would be addressed. So we would like to have a prehearing conference. Again, I'm available anytime you choose to call us before you, and we're available for a hearing at any time it's convenient for you. We would like to expedite this matter, and the soonest date possible would be our preference.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Bruce?

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, prehearing conference,
I understand that you're unavailable Tuesday afternoon of
next week, but anytime in the first three days of that week
may work, for a couple hours or maybe an hour or two
prehearing conference. And then as to a special hearing
date, that is at your decision.

EXAMINER STOGNER: I'll be available Monday afternoon, or all day Monday, and the morning of Tuesday the 23rd. How about Monday afternoon the 22nd?

MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir. 1 2 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 3 EXAMINER STOGNER: That would work for you guys, 4 about 1:30? 5 MR. BRUCE: That would be fine. 6 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay. Now, as far as a 7 special hearing date, are we going to need to reserve this 8 room for one or two days, or three? 9 MR. KELLAHIN: I would suggest two, Mr. Examiner, 10 and at the prehearing conference we could be more specific, 11 but as of today I would think it's a two-day hearing. 12 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay. 13. MR. KELLAHIN: Jim? MR. BRUCE: I would agree, Mr. Examiner. 14 15 haven't checked exactly on the availability of hearing 16 dates, but certainly we can address a final hearing date on 17 Monday afternoon. 18 EXAMINER STOGNER: Why don't we reserve that 19 until Monday afternoon? Be aware, as far as the October 20 29th through Friday the 2nd, this room will be occupied 21 mid-day on Monday and mid-day on Hallowe'en for a very 22 important meeting. 23 And then of course Thursday the 1st is an Examiner Hearing. I wish I can say 7th and 8th was really 24 25 what we could do, but there's a meeting in Albuquerque I
