the minutes of the hearing held by the Commission on
November 22nd, 2002.

5	We have a couple of cases that we do to plan to
6	take action in this year, but it will not be today. We
7	will continue these cases to a special Commission meeting
8	that will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 19th.
9	And those cases are Case 12,734 this is the
10	Application of Richardson Operating Company to establish a
11	special "infill well" area within the Basin-Fruitland Coal
12	Gas Pool as an exception from Rule 4 of the special rules
13	for this pool in San Juan County, New Mexico and also
14	Case 12,897 this is the Application of the New Mexico
15	Oil Conservation Division through the Environmental Bureau
16	Chief for the adoption of amendments to Division Rule 118
17	we need to consider a couple of clerical corrections to
18	the text of the Rule that was adopted on November 22nd.
19	But as I said, we'll do both of those cases next Thursday.
20	And then we also had a couple of cases on the
21	agenda that will be continued to the Commission's hearing
22	in January, and those are Cases 12,792 it's the
23	Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for
24	an order requiring Kelly H. Baxter to properly plug seven
25	wells in Lea County, New Mexico and Case 12,828, the

3	those will be heard in January.

8	Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to
9	amend Rules 303.B, 309.B, Rule 309.C, and to make
10	conforming amendments to Rule 303.A and 309.A.
11	And we took testimony in this matter at the
12	Commission Hearing on November 22nd. We left the record
13	open for additional comments until I'm drawing a blank
14	on the date. It was the
15	COMMISSIONER BAILEY:13th.
16	CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: the 13th of December. I
17	believe we got one additional comment, then, from Marathon
18	during that time period. They sent an e-mail note in
19	support of the Rule. And we did also, I believe, have the
20	staff talk with the staff of the Land Office in the
21	meantime, to make sure that the Land Office staff was
22	comfortable with the changes that the Commission requested
23	at the November 22nd hearing.
