They contend that our drilling and completions costs are too high and they will protest. They ask for another AFE in line with our expected operation. Should we go forward with our hearing in Santa Fe next Thursday, Oct. 7, we will need a drilling and completion engineer at the hearing.

Should something change, I will let you know. We have an offer out to Harvey Yates for a Term Assignment of \$250/acre @ 80% NRI. We have left the door open for them to counter.

Peggy,

As requested I called Gordon Yaney (geologist) and eventually ended up adding Leonard Carpenter (Engineer) to the conversation. Gordon indicated that he was somewhat disgruntled with our having forced pooled them and inferred that we have an inflated AFE in an effort to take them out for \$200/acre w/ an 80% NRI (?). He did state that it would take much more than that for what it is worth. I assured him that the numbers were not inflated. Gordon went on to state that they could drill a replacement well less than the AFE we submitted for the re-entry. Leonard made the same claim later and asked if we thought the re-entry was the optimum location since there was not cost savings to be realized based upon their AFE for a new well. He also asked whether we thought we would make a well since the Morrow has had fluid on it for so long. They contend they need to contact their lawyer in regards to the hearing by close of business today and asked that someone call them to discuss the completion issues this afternoon. Below you will find the specific questions they raised regarding our AFE.

Drilling:

Drilling days - we have 11 days and they contend it should take 6 days. Their estimate assumes no logging so you would have to back 1-1/2 days off of our estimate to normalize. I believe 8 days is a best case. (3 days @ 20M/day = \$60M)

Casing design - they believe a combination of 5-1/2", 17# N-80 and S-95 would suffice based upon their stimulations. They wanted to know what

maximum treating pressure we based our design upon. (If possible, that would result in +/- \$40M reduction)

They questioned bringing cement up to the intermediate casing shoe if not required by the regulatory agency. (\$20M savings if possible).

They believe the estimated for mud is \$20M too high.

They contend that the logs from the original hole are adequate and indicated they thought cores and pressures were obtained then. (\$25M reduction if eliminated)

Completion

Inspection services - \$20M?

Supervision & technical charges - \$21M?

Completion rig - \$65M? How long is the completion estimated to take?

Pipe, equipment, and labor - \$25M? For what?

Perforating - \$30M? How long an interval? What technique in light of fluid having been on the Morrow?

Stimulation - \$300M? They spend \$150M on binary fracs

Wireline services - \$30M? For what?

Surface equipment - \$70M? What is included in that?

Subsurface equipment - \$10M? Doesn't know what that could be.

Pipeline & Meter - \$35M? Asked how long to the tie in point in light of the magnitude of the dollars.


