WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:22 a.m.: EXAMINER STOGNER: So at this time I will call 3 4 Case Number 13,388, which is the Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for approval of a unit agreement, Lea 5 County, New Mexico. 6 7 Call for appearances, please. 8 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, my name is Ocean 9 Munds-Dry. I'm with Holland and Hart and I'm here on behalf of Yates Petroleum Corporation this morning, and I'm 10 11 appearing with William F. Carr. 12 EXAMINER STOGNER: Any other appearances for 13 Yates, 13,388? 14 Ms. Munds-Dry? MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr. Hearing 15 Examiner. Yates seeks approval of the Azure State 16 17 Exploratory Unit and seeks approval of this proposed unit by affidavit pursuant to Division policy. 18 19 I put before you Exhibit 1, the affidavit of John 20 Amiet. This unit is comprised of approximately 2220 acres 21 of State of New Mexico lands. It's located approximately 22 six miles west of Tatum. 23 You will see the affidavit before you is from 24 John Amiet, petroleum geologist, and he's identifying the 25 project in the affidavit.

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You will see Attachment A is a fully executed 1 copy of a unit agreement. This does conform to the State 2 3 Land Office form. 4 You will see Attachment B to the affidavit is a 5 copy of the plat to the executed unit agreement identifying 6 the unit boundaries. The initial test well is to be located at a standard gas well location 1480 feet from the 7 west line and 1050 feet from the north line of Section 18, 8 and this will test all formations from the surface to an 9 10 approximate total depth of 12,775 feet. You will see Attachment C to the affidavit is a 11 copy of the ownership breakdown. You will notice that 100 12 percent of the working interest is owned by Yates and its 13 affiliated companies. You will also see in this list that 14 15 100 percent is voluntarily committed to the unit. This means that Yates will have complete control of the 16 17 operations. Mr. Hearing Examiner, you will see Attachment D 18 to the affidavit is a letter from the Commissioner of 19 20 Public Lands giving preliminary approval to the formation. Attachment D [sic] to the affidavit is a net sand 21 22 isopach map for the Atoka-Morrow sands illustrating Yates' 23 projection of the sand trend in this area. Atoka-Morrow 24 sands are the primary, main producing objective of this 25 unit. Yates is attempting to locate channel sands by

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1 utilizing 3-D seismic, log correlation and regional 2 mapping. Although these gas sands can be very productive, the channels are often narrow and limited in areal extent. 3 4 The target sand channels on this map are shown 5 with red lines on the Austin isopach map. You'll also see 6 the productive Atoka-Morrow wells shown on the map by 7 purple circles. Attachment F to the affidavit is a structural 8 9 cross-section of the Atoka-Morrow sands in the proposed 10 area. It shows a channel system eroding in the underlying 11 Austin limestone. 12 Mr. Hearing Examiner, Mr. Amiet testifies in his 13 affidavit that there's no production from any horizon 14 inside the proposed unit area. Mr. Amiet also testifies 15 that the development of this unit area pursuant to a unit 16 plan is in the best interests of conservation, the 17 prevention of waste and the protection of correlative 18 rights. 19 We ask at this time that Yates Exhibit Number 1 20 be admitted into evidence, as well as its attachments, and 21 we ask that this matter be taken under advisement. 22 EXAMINER STOGNER: Exhibit Number 1 and all of 23 its attachments will be admitted into evidence at this 24 time. 25 Do you know if there's any expiring leases coming

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1 up or what the expiration date is, perhaps -- oh, it's there in Attachment C. I see it now. Is that in -- what, 2 3 the fourth column? 4 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Right, it gives the expiration 5 dates on there. 6 EXAMINER STOGNER: So it looks like there's --MS. MUNDS-DRY: All the --7 EXAMINER STOGNER: -- the earliest one would be 8 9 January 1st; is that correct? 10 MS. MUNDS-DRY: That's my understanding, Mr. 11 Hearing Examiner. EXAMINER STOGNER: Anybody have any questions or 12 13 anything further in this matter? 14 In that case, Case Number 13,388 will be taken 15 under advisement. 16 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you. 17 EXAMINER STOGNER: Thank you. Oh, 18 congratulations, this is your first case. 19 MS.
