

CASE 13371: *This case will be continued to the November 18, 2004, Examiner Hearing Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Compliance Order.* The Applicant seeks an order requiring Lindenmuth & Associates, Inc. to bring one well into compliance with 19.15.4.201 NMAC; imposing a civil penalty; authorizing the Division to plug said well in the event of noncompliance and forfeit the applicable financial assurance; and for such other relief as the Director deems appropriate. The affected well is the Post #001 well, API # 30-025-27984, located at Unit Letter N, Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 37 East; approximately 15 miles northeast of Lovington in Lea County New Mexico.

CASE 13354: *Continued from October 7, 2004, Examiner Hearing Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Compliance Order, Lea County, New Mexico.* The Applicant seeks an order requiring Tahoe Energy Inc. and Kenneth A. Freeman dba Tahoe Energy Inc. to bring one well into compliance with 19.15.4.201 NMAC by a date certain and, in the event of non-compliance, assessing a civil penalty, authorizing the Division to plug said well, forfeiting the applicable plugging security, and for such other relief as the Director deems appropriate. The affected well is the Brownlee #1, API # 30-025-04461, Unit Letter P, Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, in Lea County, New Mexico. The well is located approximately 3 miles west of Eunice, New Mexico.

CASE 13361: *Continued from October 21, 2004, Examiner Hearing Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Compliance Order.* The Applicant seeks an order requiring Millard Deck Estate to bring two wells into compliance with 19.15.4.201 NMAC, imposing a civil penalty and authorizing the Division to plug said wells in the event of noncompliance, and for such other relief as the Director deems appropriate. The affected wells are: Alexander #001, API #30-025-06429, located at Unit Letter E, Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, approximately three miles east of Oil Center, in Lea County, New Mexico; and Lea 407 State #005, API #30-025-03535, located at Unit Letter D, Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, approximately 12 miles west of Eunice in Lea County, New Mexico.

CASE 13362: *Continued from October 21, 2004, Examiner Hearing Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Compliance Order.* The Applicant seeks an order requiring operator KC Resources Inc. to remediate contamination at a tank battery site in compliance with 19.15.3.116.D NMAC and bring three inactive wells into compliance with 19.15.4.201 NMAC; authorizing the Division to plug said wells and ordering a forfeiture of the applicable plugging bond if the operator fails to comply; and assessing civil penalties. The tank battery is located at the site of the Lea YH State #003, API #30-025-26562, J-25-18S-34E, NMPM. The inactive wells are the Lea YH State #001, API #30-025-26104, O-25-18S-34E, NMPM; the Lea YH State #002, API #30-025-26299, P-25-18S-34E, NMPM; and the Lea YH State #004, API #30-025-26687, I-25-18S-34E, NMPM. The tank battery and wells are located approximately 22 miles west of Hobbs in Lea County, New Mexico.
