I have received your letter dated January 7, 2005, whereby you have advised the Division that the East Shugart Delaware Unit Well No. 21, an approved injection well within this secondary recovery project which was originally proposed to be drilled 1193 feet from the North line and 1018 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 19, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, will now be drilled at a location 1425 feet from the North line and 1000 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 19. It is our understanding that the well had to be moved due to topographic considerations.

You are hereby authorized to drill the East Shugart Delaware Unit Well No. 21 at the new location described above.


