

Matrix New Mexico Holdings, L.L.C. has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation in NE/4 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Bronco-Wolfcamp Pool. MATRIX NEW MEXICO HOLDINGS, L.L.C. ("Matrix") through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17(C), for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface through the base of the Wolfcamp formation in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Bronco-Wolfcamp Pool, and in support thereof states:

1. Matrix is a working interest owner in the NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 10 and has the right to drill thereon.
2. Matrix proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit to its Townsend Well No. 3 to be drilled at a standard oil well within the NE/4 SE/4 of this section to a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface through the Wolfcamp formation.
3. Matrix has sought and been unable to obtain a voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from those interest owners identified on Exhibit A to this application.
4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
5. In order to permit Matrix the opportunity to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Matrix New Mexico Operating Company, L.L.C. should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.



- C. authorizing Matrix New Mexico Holdings, L.L.C. to recover its costs of drilling,

- equipping and completing the well,
- D. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures, and
- E. imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Matrix New Mexico Holdings, L.L.C. in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner that does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.
