# APPLICATION OF MYCO INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR AN EXCEPTION TO DIVISION RULE 104.C(2)(c), EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

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#### **APPLICATION**

Myco Industries, Inc. ("Myco"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order granting an exception to Division Rule 104.C(2)(c) allow two operators in all formations developed on 320-acres within the N/2 of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico and in support of its application states:

1. Myco is a working interest owner in the N/2 of Section 35 and has drilled its Boise Federal Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-31648) at a legal location in Unit H of Section 35 at a depth sufficient to test the Carlsbad Morrow East Gas Pool.

Delta Petroleum Corporation is the Division-designated operator in the N/2 of Section 35 and presently operates the Delta's Reeves Federal Well No. 2 (API No. 30-015-22330) located in Unit C at a point 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 35. This well is currently completed in and producing from the Carlsbad Morrow East Gas Pool.

3. Division Rule 104.C(2)(c) requires the operator of any infill well on a 320-acre unit to be the same as the operator of the initial well. Myco desires to operate its Boise Federal Well No. 1 and therefore seeks an exception to this rule.

4. Delta Petroleum Corporation, the Division-designated operator in the N/2 of Section 35, has been contacted and does not oppose this application.

5. Approval of this application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Myco requests that this application be set for hearing before a Division Examiner on March 3, 2005, and that after notice and hearing as required by law and the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Division, the Division enter its order granting this application.
