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STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order: (1) creating a non-standard spacing unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 29 and the W/2 E/2 of Irregular Section 32, Township 26 South, Range 28 East, NMPM and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in the non-standard spacing unit which will be the project area for the Honey Graham State Com No. 3H to be drilled from a surface location 330 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 29 and a bottomhole location 330 feet from the South line and 2310 feet from the East line of Section 32. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating, LLC as operator of the well and a

200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 15 miles North of Malaga, New Mexico.


