1           WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at  
2   8:15 a.m.:

3           EXAMINER STOGNER: Good morning, happy St.  
4   Patrick's Day. Today is Thursday, March 17th, 2005, Docket  
5   Number 09-05. I'm Michael Stogner, appointed Hearing  
6   Officer in today's cases.

7           We'll go through the continuances and dismissals.

8           Page 1, Case 13,405. This is the Application of  
9   Yates Petroleum Corporation for compulsory pooling, Eddy  
10   County, New Mexico; this case will be continued to April  
11   21st. The next two on this page, 13,445 and 13,446, both  
12   are Applications of EOG Resources, Inc., for compulsory  
13   pooling in Lea County, New Mexico; both of these cases are  
14   dismissed.

15           On the second page, amended Case 13,417, this is  
16   the Application of Huntington Energy, L.L.C., for  
17   compulsory pooling, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico; this  
18   case will be continued to April the 7th. Case 13,418 is  
19   another amended Application of Huntington Energy, L.L.C.,  
20   for compulsory pooling, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico; this  
21   case is continued to April the 7th. Case 13,416,  
22   Application of Nadel and Gussman Permian, LLC, for  
23   compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico; this case will  
24   be continued to April 7th. Last one on this page, Case  
25   13,433, Application of Myco Industries, Inc., for an

1 exception to Division Rule 104.C.(2).(c), Eddy County, New  
2 Mexico -- for the record, this is 320-acre spacing because  
3 it's deep -- this case will be dismissed.

4 On page 3, Case 13,447, this is the Application  
5 of Myco Industries, Inc., for compulsory pooling, Eddy  
6 County, New Mexico; this case will be continued to April  
7 7th. The next one, 13,448, Application of Myco Industries,  
8 Inc., for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico, will  
9 also be continued to April 7th. Case 13,421, Application  
10 of Mewbourne Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy  
11 County, New Mexico; this case will be continued to April  
12 21st.

13 Page 4, nothing on this page.

14 Let's go to page 5. Down toward the bottom, Case  
15 13,274, this is the Application of Arch Petroleum, Inc.,  
16 and Westbrook Oil Corporation for approval of two  
17 nonstandard gas spacing and proration units in the Jalmat  
18 Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico; this case, which actually  
19 was heard some time ago but had to be reopened at this time  
20 for notification issues, will now be continued to April  
21 7th.

22 Any other continuances or dismissals at this  
23 time?

24 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on page 4 --

25 EXAMINER STOGNER: Page 4.

1 MR. BRUCE: -- and the top of page 5, there are  
2 two OGX Resources cases, 13,428 and 13,429. They were  
3 companion cases to the EOG cases, and I request that they  
4 be dismissed.

5 EXAMINER STOGNER: Cases 13,428 and 13,429, both  
6 of which are Application of OGX Resources, LLC, for  
7 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico, are now  
8 dismissed.

9 Any others?

10 MR. BRUCE: At the top of page 4, I didn't get  
11 the final documents in, so I ask that this case be  
12 continued to April 7th, Chi Energy, 13,381.

13 EXAMINER STOGNER: Case 13,381, which is the  
14 Application of Chi Energy, Inc., for compulsory pooling,  
15 Eddy County, New Mexico; this case will be continued again  
16 to April 7th; is that correct, sir?


17 MR. BRUCE: April 7th, yes.


