By letter dated April 12, 2004, the Plan of Development (POD) for the calendar year 2004 was filed by Energen Resources Corporation (Unit Operator) and provided for the drilling of the Carracas Canyon Unit #26B 7, Pictured Cliffs well in the NE⁴ of Section 26-T32N-R4W. The well was drilled, completed and is presently producing. A Commercial Determination Application will be filed once adequate history has been developed on the well.
