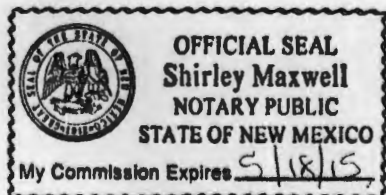

Mewbourne Oil Company
has filed an application
with the New Mexico Oil
Conservation Division
seeking an order approv-
ing an 160-acre non-
standard oil spacing and
proration unit (project
area) in the Bone Spring
formation comprised of
the S/2S/2 of Section 17,
Township 20 South,
Range 29 East, NMPM.
Applicant further seeks
the pooling of all mineral
interests in the Bone
Spring formation underly-
ing the S/2S/2 of Section
17 to form a non-standard
160-acre oil spacing and
proration unit (project
area) for all pools or for-
mations developed on 40
acre spacing within that
vertical extent. The unit
will be dedicated to the
Glock 17 MP Fed. Well No.
1H; a horizontal well with
a surface location in the
SW/4SW/4, and a termi-
nus in the SE/4SE/4, of
Section 17. Also to be
considered will be the
cost of drilling and com-
pleting the well and the
allocation of the cost
thereof, as well as actual
operating costs and
charges for supervision,
designation of applicant
as operator of the well,
and a 200% charge for
the risk involved in drill-
ing and completing the
well. The application is
scheduled to be heard at
8:15 a.m. on Thursday,
October 31, 2013 at the
Division's offices at 1220
South St. Francis Drive,
Santa Fe, New Mexico
87505. As an interest
owner in the well-unit you
have the right to enter an
appearance and partici-
pate in the case. Failure
to appear will preclude
you from contesting this
matter at a later date.
