STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT:

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order from the Division amending
the vertical depths of its Lewis Unit, pursuant to 19.15.20.14 NMAC, and approving
a 80-acre non-standard proration unit for the Lewis Unit No. 1 well (API No. 30-

025-33350), covering the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 3 and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 4, Township 10 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. The amended unitized interval for the Lewis Unit will be from the top of the Glorieta formation, the correlative interval of which is identified in the logged depths of 5,643 feet, defined in the Borehole Compensated Sonic/Gamma Ray log formulated by Schlumberger on the Gainer 22 #1 well (API: 30-025-38792), located in Section 22, Township 10 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, NM, down to the base of the Devonian formation, the correlative interval of which is identified in the logged depths of 12,513 feet, defined in the Acoustic Velocity log formulated by Welex on the T&P State #1 well (API: 30-025-20006), located in Section 10, Township 10 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This amendment is being requested in order to allow Apache Corporation to develop its Fire Eagle San Andres Unit, which was approved by the Division in Order No. R-14093. In addition, Applicant requests that the Division either amend Order R-10554, creating the Lewis Unit, or issue an order which recognizes that the Lewis Unit No. 1 well was drilled to develop the entire 80 acres included within the boundaries of the Lewis Unit. This amendment has been requested by the Division, in order to clarify the records for the Lewis Unit No. 1 well. Said acreage is located approximately 5.8 miles Southeast of Crossroads, New Mexico.
