That is the 5 Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division 6 Compliance and Enforcement Manager for Compliance Order 7 against Dominion Production Operating, LLC. 8 It's my understanding and -- well, let me 9 call for appearances. MR. HALL: Mr. Chairman, Commissioners, my name 10 is Scott Hall, Montgomery and Andrews law firm, Santa Fe, 11 appearing on behalf the de novo applicant Dominion 12 13 Production Company. 14 MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Keith Herrmann representing the Oil Conservation Division's Compliance 15 and Enforcement Manager. 16 17 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Okay. Any other 18 appearances? 19 What are we doing here? MR. HALL: Not much. It's pretty fast. 20 21 Yesterday we were able to secure my client's signature to a settlement agreement which we can 22 present to the Division for its consideration later today. 23 24 But this resolves the compliance issues in the farflung 25 Hospah field in McKinley County. I think we are on a

Page 4 schedule now to bring that field back into compliance and 1 2 production. As part of the settlement agreement it 3 4 provides that Dominion will dismiss it's de Novo appeal, 5 so that we make that request to you today. Then after the 6 Division accepts the settlement agreement then the original Division proceeding and its attendant Compliance 7 Order will also be dismissed. 8 9 MR. HERRMANN: And the Division issued an Order R-14132. That will also be vacated. 10 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: And this settlement 11 12 agreement was negotiated between Dominion and the Division? 13 14 MR. HALL: Yes. 15 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: And the Division is in 16 agreement with this settlement agreement? 17 MR. HERRMANN: Yes. COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Okay. Does that require 18 Division signature on that settlement agreement? 19 20 MR. HALL: I believe so. 21 Yes. It will require signature, MR. HERRMANN: sign-off by the Special New Mexico Assistant Attorney 22 General and the Director of the Oil Conservation Division. 23 24 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Has Dominion executed 25 that agreement?

Page 5 1 MR. HALL: Yes. 2 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Oh, Okay. I guess we can go ahead and dismiss the 3 4 case? 5 MR. BRANCARD: So are you moving to dismiss the 6 case? 7 MR. We'll go back to the Division, have the Division 8 execute the agreement, then we will dismiss the Division 9 case and the Division Order then. 10 We are a little bit out of order because 11 12 this case was noticed first, so we wanted to take care of this side of the business first. 13 14 MR. BRANCARD: Do you think the Division has the authority to dismiss its prior order? 15 It is represented that it does to me. 16 MR. HALL: 17 MR. HERRMANN: Well, we could prepare a Commission Order vacating the original order and 18 dismissing both cases. 19 MR. BRANCARD: Yeah, that might be better, and 20 21 then the Commission implements the settlement agreement. All right. I'll do that. 22 MR. HALL: 23 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Do we need to do that 24 today, Mr. Brancard? 25 MR. BRANCARD: Well --
