The next order of business on today's docket is the deliberation of 3 Case Number 15437, which is the de novo application of 4 Caza Petroleum, Inc. for a nonstandard oil spacing and 5 proration unit and compulsory pooling in Lea County, 6 7 New Mexico. In Caza's case, we believe that they did 13 not prove unavoidable waste of the reserves in the 14 southwest quarter. 15 Legacy showed that their correlative rights 16 17 will be immediately affected in the granting of Caza's application, and drilling two one-mile laterals in the 18 west half of the west half of Sections 18 and 19 will 19 likely result in reduced recovery of oil due to setback 20 21 requirements. So that's the final decision in that case. 22 23 Mr. Feldewert, would you be so kind as to 24 draft an order that we can use as a starting point. 25 MR. FELDEWERT: I normally would, but I was
