As requested, enclosed are four plats showing alternative rig pad configurations for the Black Mountain State Com No. 1H and the State Com No. 3H in Sections 2 and 35, T22S, R34E.

- 1. This plat shows the currently planned single pad location for both wells in the area (hatched) suggested by 3Bear Energy as a location of a possible gas plant.
- 2. This plat shows a single pad for both wells in the southwest corner of Section 2 outside of the gas plant acreage.
- 3. This plat shows two pads, both located outside the gas plant acreage on either side.
- 4. This plat shows a single pad for both wells located in Section 11.

All configurations are possible, but a single pad located in Section 11 is the most preferable alternative. Black Mountain has also conferred with 3Bear Energy and is informed that there is a strong likelihood that the gas plant project will not go forward.
