Dear Ms. Binon:

The Encana 2018 Plan of Development (POD) for the Good Times Unit (GTU) located in San Juan County, New Mexico is not approved as of March 7, 2018 because there is no plan for further development. The GTU contains 14,706.5 acres of Federal, State and Allotted minerals with three producing Mancos wells. All three of these wells GTU #301H, #302H, #303H and #304H first produced in Dec. 2015. There has been no well development by Encana Oil & Gas within GTU in over 3 years.

Your 2018 plan contains only installation of valves to isolate and de-pressure the tank vapor recovery system for increased safe operation but no well development.

Because of our fiduciary responsibilities we are requiring POD's to emphasize annual work be performed to benefit primarily Navajo Allotted interests but also the general public interest. GTU has three Navajo Allotments within its boundaries.
