16. Case No. 16092: Amended Application of Advance Energy Partners Hat Mesa, LLC for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order approving a non-standard 320-acre± oil spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring Formation (97895) comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 15 and the E/2 W/2 of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and pooling all mineral interests underlying the non-standard unit. The unit will be dedicated to Applicant's proposed **Stock Unit #601H** well to be drilled from an approximate surface location 100 feet from the north line and 1,650 feet from the west line of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 33 East to a bottomhole location 330 feet from the south line and 1,650 feet from the west line of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost, the designation of Applicant as Operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk of drilling and completing the well. The well and lands are located approximately 2.5 miles northeast of Hat Mesa, New Mexico.
