Applicant seeks to pool (i) the W/2 of Section 30 and W/2 of Section 31, and (ii) the E/2 of Section 30 and E/2 of Section 31, both in Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, in the Wolfcamp formation.

OPPONENT

Kaiser-Francis Oil Company has filed pooling applications with the Division covering (i) the W/2 of Section 19 and NW/4 of Section 30, and (ii) the E/2 of Section 19 and NE/4 of Section 30, both in Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, in the Wolfcamp formation. The N/2 of Section 30 is at issue in both cases, and thus there is a conflict as to what acreage should be pooled.. These cases are set for hearing on July 26, 2018.


