STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the W/2 of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM (Purple-Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool) to form a standard 320 acre gas spacing and proration unit. The unit will be dedicated to the Jack Sleeper 09-23S-28E RB Well No. 201H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SW/4SW/4, and a bottomhole location in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 9. The producing interval will be unorthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Matador Production Company as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.

Novo has filed two Applications, one to pool the mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation in the W/2 of Section 9, and another to pool the mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in the W/2W/2 of Section 9. These cases are to be set for hearing on August 9, 2018.
