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STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 16295, Applicant seeks an order from the Division: (1) creating a non-standard 320-acre, more or less, oil spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation, comprised of the E/4 of Sections 32, Township 25 South, Range 33 East and E/4 of Section 5, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and, (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying

this proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit. This proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the **Red Hills Unit 127H**, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for this well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Cimarex as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well.
